### **It's Bed Time in East Hope....And we're Dreaming Big!**

We're all so proud of our new community park, but now we need your help. We need gardeners, families and/or groups to donate their time and gardening talents to adopt one of our garden beds starting spring of 2023. Your commitment (of approximately 6 visits a year) will require a little weeding, a little pruning and a whole lot of love. A dozen beds of various sizes are available for adoption: Veteran Memorial, the Lumberjack, the Wellington's (Mr & Mrs), the Monument, Maple's End, Weeping River (currently adopted), Pearl, Warren, Cottage and the Cove. Also future beds to come, the Shady Grove (future picnic area), The Hollow (future bed) and the Wellington Strips, front and back (future bed). Please contact the City for further information if you are interested or have further questions.

### **Public Notary Services:**

The city clerk is a Notary Public. The City will be offering this service during business hours. You may contact the City if you have additional questions.

### **Burn Permits:**

Don't forget, burn permits are still required until October 20th. Currently burn permits are not being issued until the weather changes some so please check with the City or Sam Owen Fire for current burn conditions.

### **Building Permit:**

The City has both building codes and zoning codes, so if you are starting a project such as a shed, deck, addition or new build please check with the City to see what permits you will need and if it meets zoning setbacks. A simple phone call or email to discuss your project will save you time and frustration as you plan for your project. We are seeing an increase in activity in the area and permits are taking 4 to 6 weeks to process so please plan your projects accordingly.

### **Vacation Rentals:**

The City has regulations concerning Vacation/Short-Term Rentals that were adopted with the new Zoning & Subdivision Ordinance #285. If you operate a Vacation Rental/Short-Term Rental, you are required to register with the City. The registration fee for the first year is \$50.00 and subsequent years are \$25.00. Vacation Rentals/Short-Term Rentals Registration forms are available to download on the City's website.

### **Water and Streets:**

It's that time of year to start winterizing your outdoor faucets and sprinkler systems. Don't forget your vehicles too, make sure you check your radiator and window washer fluids for the appropriate levels. It's also a good time of year to change the batteries in your smoke detectors and clean your chimney. Daylight Savings time ends November 6th, remember to set your clocks back 1 hour on the Saturday night the 5th.

### **Be Prepared! Winter Snow Removal Requirements:**

Snow plowing season is coming and the City is asking for your cooperation. East Hope streets are narrow, please do not park in public right-of-way areas this makes plowing extremely difficult. The City will not be held responsible for damage done to vehicles that are located within its right-of-ways. The City is asking that you do not shovel or plow snow into the City's streets. This causes a safety hazard for other motorists and the City's snow removal equipment.

### **Annual Tree Lighting Celebration:**

## HALLOWEEN BACON JALAPENO MUMMIES

### Ingredients

8-10 large jalapenos  
1 cup shredded pepper jack cheese  
1 container crescent roll dough

8 ounce cream cheese softened  
6 sliced cooked bacon  
40 candy eyes

### Instructions

Preheat oven to 400 degrees. In a small bowl add cream cheese, pepper jack cheese and chopped up bacon. Mix until combined. Slice the jalapenos in half lengthwise and seed and core them. Spoon in cream cheese mixture into jalapenos. Pinch two crescent rolls together to form a rectangle. With a knife or pizza cutter slice each rectangle into 10 thin strips. Wrap 2-3 strips around stuffed jalapenos. Make sure to leave some space for the eyes. Bake 12-14 minutes. Remove from the oven and let cool 10 minutes. Place the candy eyes into the jalapenos.
