**2023 City Elections:** It's that time again, city elections will be held on November 7th of this year. There will be two city council positions and the mayor position on the ballot. The two city council positions are four year terms and the mayor position is also a four year term. Candidate declaration opens Monday, August 28th and goes through September 8th. Forms are available at city hall.

**Park Updates:** The City is still looking for donations to help with finishing the park. The center of the park is looking beautiful this year. Our goal is to work on the west side of the center grassy area and continue the green area over to the David Thompson Memorial leaving room for a pavilion area. To make this happen we need more funding. It is estimated that to complete the park (without the pavilion expense) the City needs to raise between \$10,000 and \$12,000 dollars. **Public Notary Services:** The city clerk is a Notary Public. The City will be offering this service during business hours Monday—Thursday. You may contact the City if you have additional questions.

**Planning & Zoning Regulations:** The City has both building codes and zoning codes, so if you are starting a project such as a shed, deck, addition or new build please check with the City to see what permits you will need and if it meets zoning setbacks. A simple phone call or email to discuss your project will save you time and frustration as you plan for your project. We are seeing an increase in activity in the area and permits are taking longer to process so please plan your projects accordingly.

**Water Quality Report:** The annual consumer confidence report on your drinking water is now available at city hall, posted at the post office or you may read in on our website: cityofeasthope.com

**Alternative Communication During an Emergency Event:** Does this sound interesting to you? Are you concerned about communicating during an emergency event when cell, internet and landlines may be down? What would you do? How would you get informed? There are some in this community that would like to create a volunteer group to explore this issue. If this is something you might be interested in, please let the City know.

**Waterfront Setback Consideration:** The City of East Hope is considering a zoning amendment that would increase the waterfront setback in the Shoreline Residential zone along Lake Pend Oreille from 50 feet to 75 to protect water quality and viewsheds. Prior to formally initiating the process, the City is seeking your comments regarding this potential change. You are encouraged to provide your written comments to the City either by dropping them off at city hall (110 School Road) or emailing (easthope.city@gmail.com) them. ## GRILLED ZUCCHINI SALAD WITH CORN AND TOMATOES

### INGREDIENTS:

2 medium zucchini, cut into 1/2 inch thick half-moons

2 cups cherry tomatoes, halved

2 1/2 cups corn kernels

2 tbsp olive oil

Salt and pepper

### FOR THE DRESSING:

3 tbsp olive oil

2tbsp lemon juice

1 clove minced garlic

1 tsp dried oregano

Salt & pepper

2 cups arugula

1/2 cup crumbled goat, blue or feta cheese

**INSTRUCTIONS:** Preheat outdoor grill to medium heat, brush grill with oil. Drizzle olive oil over sliced zucchini and season with salt and pepper. Grill zucchini for 2 to 3 minutes per side or until tender and grill marks appear. At same time, grab a grill pan and combine tomatoes and corn inside the pan, drizzle with tablespoon of olive oil and season with salt and pepper. Set grill pan on grill and cook, stirring frequently until tomatoes and corn are charred, about 2-3 minutes. In a salad bowl, whisk together 3 tablespoons olive oil, lemon juice, garlic, oregano salt and pepper. To the bowl, add zucchini, tomatoes, corn, and arugula; toss to coat with dressing. Top with cheese.
