

## **Hey did you know about “Transparent Idaho”?**

Transparent Idaho is an interactive site where you can find reports for budgets, fund balances, salaries and more for every state agency, county or city. If looking for information regarding East Hope, you would first click on the “city” tab, this page will give you all kinds of information regarding cities. If you scroll down the page there is a search bar that will allow you to locate specific cities and their information.

Also, cities have many state reporting requirements, one of those yearly requirement is reporting our finance information to the State of Idaho Controllers Office. On this website: <https://sco.idaho.gov/LivePages/transparencymenu.aspx> you can click the “Local Government Registry” tab, and click on the “Quarterly Compliance Report” tab to check if your county or city is compliant with their report requirements.

Both of these sites have great information about your state, county and city government. Please check them out.



The City is always looking for volunteers that love working with plants and would be interested in helping with the planting beds in the park, please give us a call or stop by the office.

**Building Permit:** The City has both building codes and zoning codes, so if you are starting a project such as a shed, deck, addition or new build please check with the City to see what permits you will need and if it meets zoning setbacks. A simple phone call or email to discuss your project will save you time and frustration as you plan for your project. We are seeing an increase in activity in the area and permits are taking 4 to 6 weeks to process so please plan your projects accordingly.

**Vacation Rentals:** The City has regulations concerning Vacation/Short-Term Rentals that were adopted with the new Zoning & Subdivision Ordinance #285. If you operate a Vacation Rental/Short-Term Rental, you are required to register with the City. The registration fee for the first year is \$50.00 and subsequent years are \$25.00. Vacation Rentals/Short-Term Rentals Registration forms are available to download on the City’s website.
